

1. INTRODUCTION

The 2011 Census data sourced from the Census Offices and collated to provide the most cost-effective and accurate datasets at Output Area level for the UK. Therefore, it is an ideal dataset for all marketing, service and planning applications.

Censuses were undertaken by the Office for National Statistics in England and Wales, National Records of Scotland, and the Northern Ireland Statistics and Research Agency. The 2011 Census data for the UK are based on the combined results of these individual censuses, which were all held on 27 March 2011 offering an accurate picture of the UK population.
