

Opening an existing project

To start mapping you need to create a project or open a project that you have created previously.

A project is used to group together a collection of map layers that have been put together in order to fulfil a specific objective. The following instructions are a step-by-step guide showing how to open an existing project so that it is ready to view, add layers to and is available for future use.

Before you begin

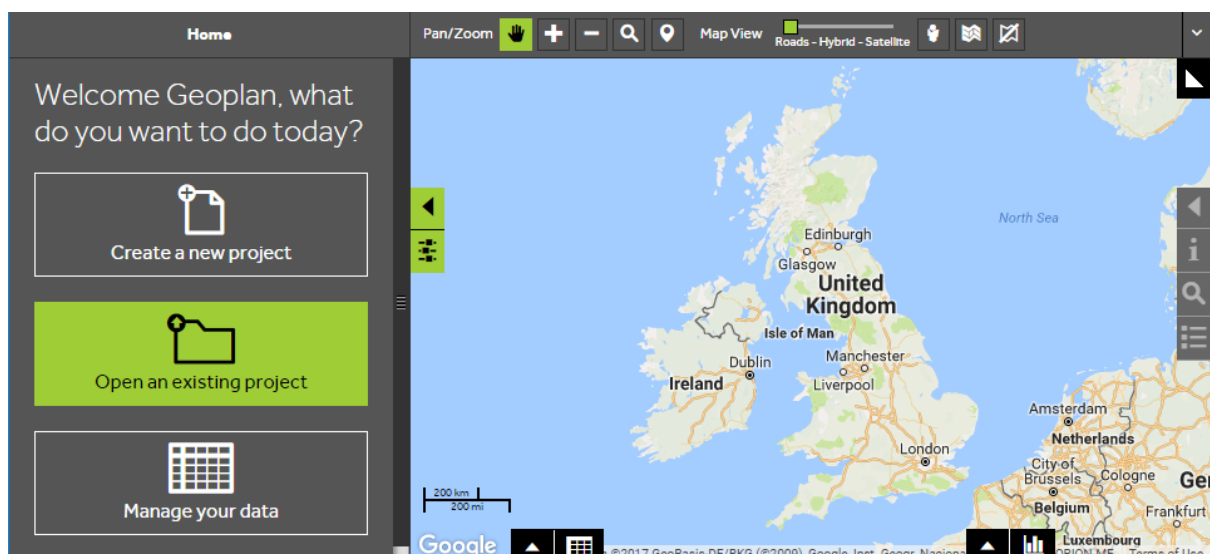
Before you open a project in SKiN you may like to see an overview of how the SKiN system works. Please refer to the following section:

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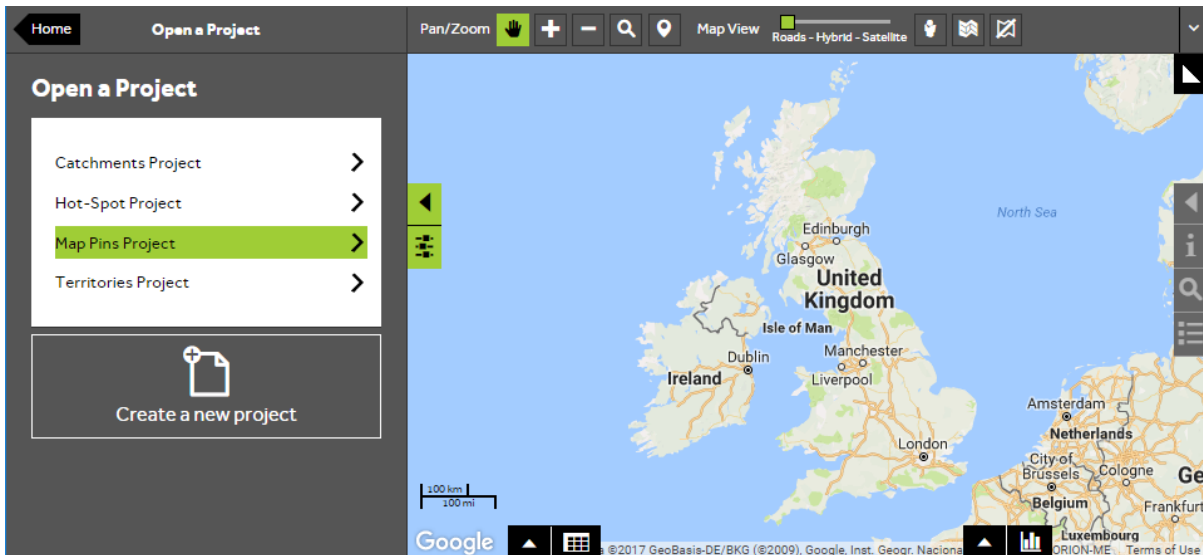
- Login to SKiN using your **username** and **password** and click on **Open an existing project**.



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Choose your project

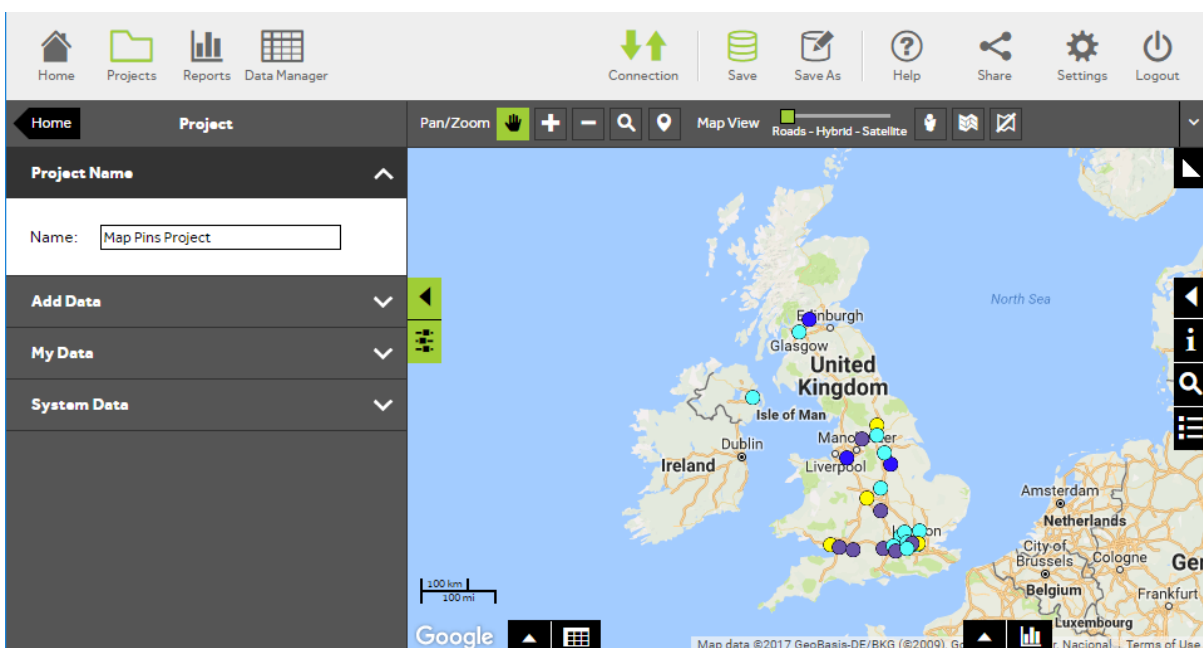
- Select the existing project from the list and click to open.



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Save your project

- To save your project click on the **Save** button above the toolbar. This will save your project with any changes you have made to the project since opening it. It is important to save your project at regular intervals as you adding layers and making changes to the project.
